SCHOOL DAY REMINDER

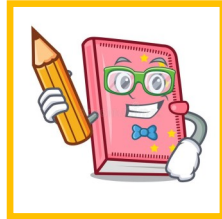

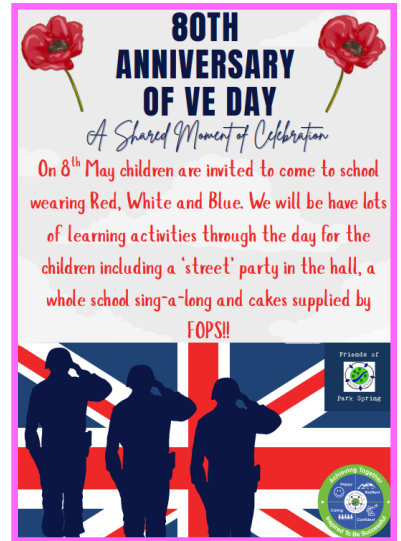


VE DAY

On Wednesday we had a whole school assembly and a representative from Zarach came and spoke to the children about the charity that the school will be adopting.

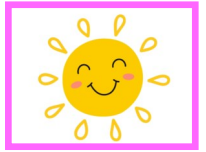
She spoke about bed poverty and how many children do not actually sleep on a proper bed. This then impacts on the children's learning at school.

Each bed bundle is £150 and includes a bed, a mattress, pillows, duvet, bedding and pyjamas, everything a child would need for a great nights sleep.
