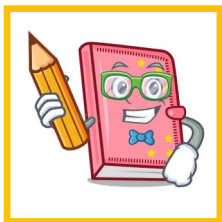

## HEADINGLEY STADIUM EXPERIENCE

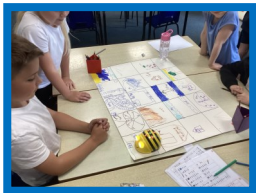


Some of our pupils recently enjoyed an exciting visit to Headingley Stadium, home of the Leeds Rhinos! As part of the day, they had the chance to try two inclusive sports: wheelchair rugby, a fast-paced, full-contact game played in specially designed wheelchairs, and goalball, a team sport designed for visually impaired players where everyone wears blindfolds and listens for a bell inside the ball. The children also had a behind-the-scenes tour of the stadium, including a visit to the Leeds Rhinos' changing room—an inspiring glimpse into the life of professional athletes! Through these activities, pupils gained a greater understanding of what it's like to play sport with a visual impairment, and learnt that Leeds Wheelchair Rugby is open to all, whether you have a disability or not. It was an unforgettable, fun-filled day for everyone involved!

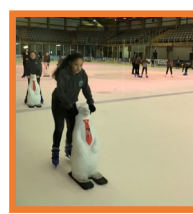
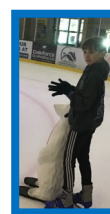
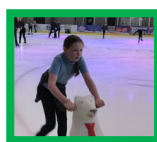
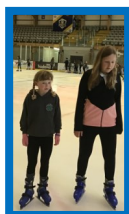
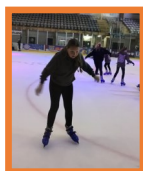
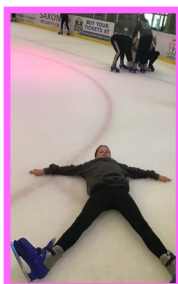
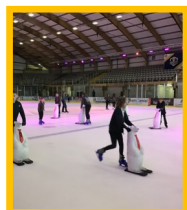
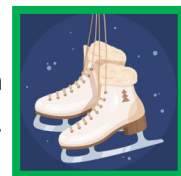
## STAFF CAR PARK

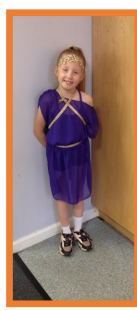
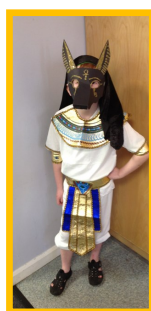
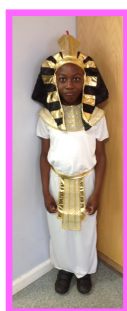
## YEAR 6 ICE SKATING

Here are a list of things that we have planned for them at the moment if you need to make a note in your diaries:

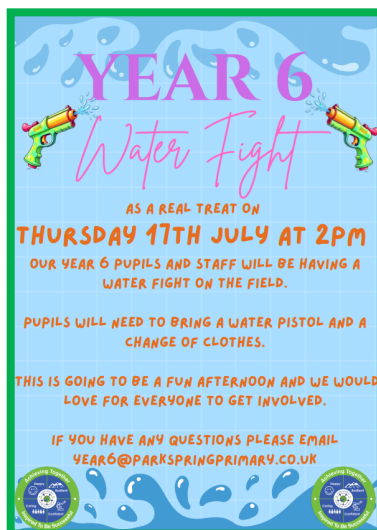
