

HEADINGLEY STADIUM EXPERIENCE

Some of our pupils recently enjoyed an exciting emerald visit to Headingley Stadium, home of the Leeds STADIUM

As part of the day, they had the chance to try two inclusive sports: wheelchair rugby, a fast-paced, full-contact game played in specially designed wheelchairs, and goalball, a team sport designed for visually impaired players where everyone wears blindfolds and listens for a bell inside the ball. The children also had a behind-the-scenes tour of the stadium,

Through these activities, pupils gained a greater understanding of what it's like to play sport with a visual impairment, and learnt that Leeds Wheelchair Rugby is open to all, whether you have a disability or not. It was an unforgettable, fun-filled day for everyone involved!
