



This week the year 6 children have been writing up their WW2 poems and have produced some lovely pieces. We have sent



home their learning for you to share at home with pride!









In art we have been learning about Henry Moore and his talent with using lines in his art. The children loved re creating his pictures and finding out lots more information about him.







YEAR 3

Year 3 had an amazing Stone Age Day at the end of last week. The children came to school dressed as Stone Age people and got



to take part in a variety of activities all day. We made our own woolly mammoths, tasted some food that they would've eaten back in the Stone Age and had a go at some drama on the field as Stone Age people.















This week in Science, Year 4 explored the fascinating world of sound and pitch. Linking Science with Music, we investigated how different sounds are made and how the pitch of

a note can change depending on the instrument and how it's played.

Using glockenspiels and xylophones, the children discovered that shorter, smaller bars create higher-pitched sounds, while longer, larger bars make lower-pitched ones. They listened carefully, compared notes, and discussed how vibrations affect what we hear.









To put their new knowledge into practice, Year 4 even had a go at performing "Count on Me" by Bruno Mars and a bit of Queen – combining science, music, and teamwork for a fun and lively lesson!

Optional Challenge! Who is your black hero?


What's the challenge?

Dear Parents,

I am delighted to inform you that following the success of previous year's courses we are expanding the football coaching programme for the season. The course will run on a weekly basis **EVERY WEDNESDAY** during school term times.

All of our courses are run by F.A. QUALIFIED COACHES INCLUDING EX-PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS. All of our coaches have been DBS/CRB POLICE CHECKED. The course is open to boys and girls aged between 4 and 13. All abilities are catered for with total beginners introduced through FUN and confidence building practices. The course is tightly structured to ensure all aspects of football skills are developed.

At the end of the term(usually 10-15 weeks) every child will receive an engraved merit trophy and course certificate, with chances to win extra trophies including penalty shoot out, american shoot out and champions league competitions.

The cost of the course is £7.50 per week, which is payable every four weeks (£30) with the first payment due on week one. Parents are welcome to stay and watch however the club is fully supervised so children may be left in our care. We have the use of excellent facilities with the course held indoors in the large sports hall.
