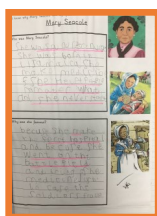
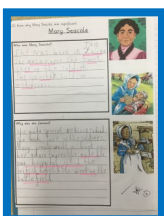
GOVERNORS

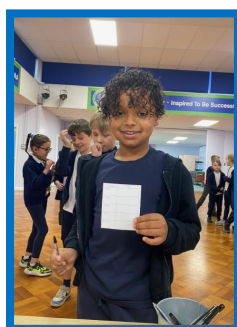
