

is a 'WOW' moment in Year 6! We are all super proud!


#### YEAR 2

Also please **do not** use mobile phones on the school grounds. Please put them away before you enter the gate—this is for safeguarding reasons.





#### Travelling by bus

The main bus stop is a 1 minute walk from the venue. If travelling from the city centre take the Number 12 bus and get off the bus at Windmill Road.

The Welcome Centre is situated in the Undercroft of Saint John and Saint Barnabas Church. When you arrive you will be shown to the drop in.



#### Travelling by car

The Welcome Centre is a 12 minute drive from Leeds City Centre. The entrance to the venue is just off Windmill Road. There is a small car park which is located around the back of the venue.

Use the venue post code in your navigation system (LS10 3DN)
