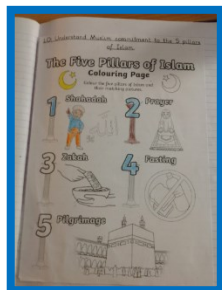
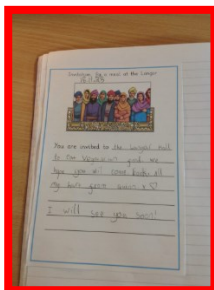
YEAR 3

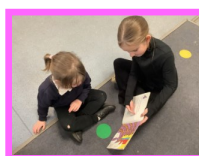
ARBOR APP

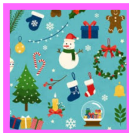

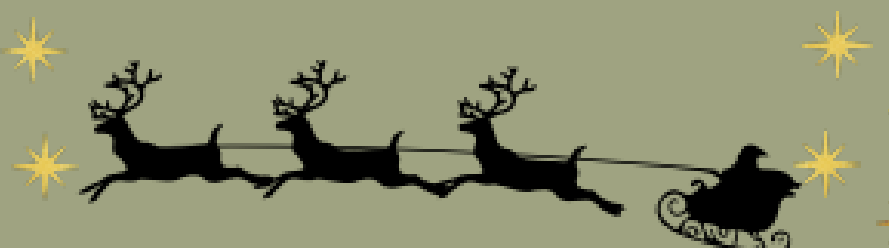
