ZARACH PJ DAY!

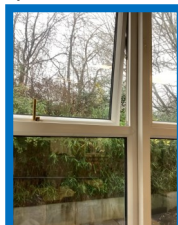
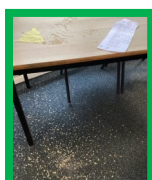

Please be aware that it is February and the weather still maybe cold, so please make sure children wear appropriate PJ's as they will be going out to play in them.



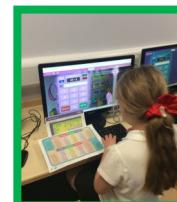
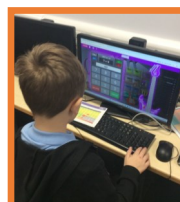
YEAR 1

Note for ALL FAMILIES. Classes will gain access to the field on a rolling programme across the next 2 weeks prior to half term. The classes allowed on the field are shown in the table below.
