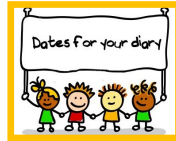
SCHOOL DAY REMINDER

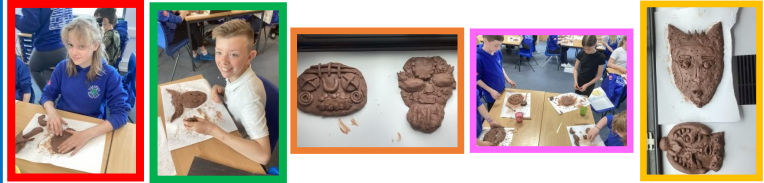

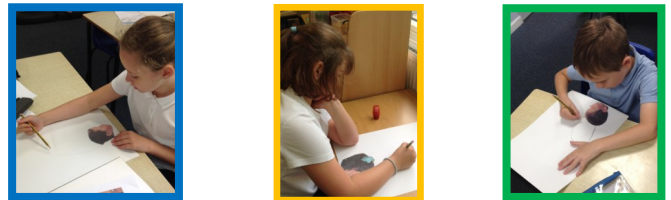
YEAR 6

SCHOOL UNIFORM



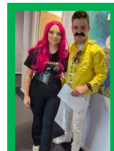
Please be reminded that we have a uniform policy at school. Children should not be coming into school with any variations. All the details can be found on our website [Uniform | Park Spring Primary School](#)
