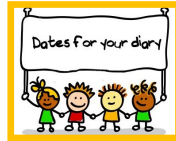
**SCHOOL DAY REMINDER**

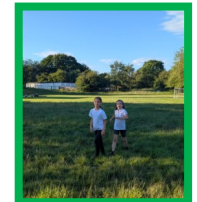
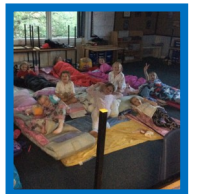
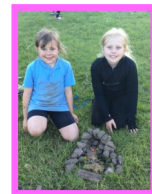
**YEAR 6**



**Achieving Together • Inspired To Be Successful**

I recognise that many families in Leeds West and Pudsey are struggling with the cost of living, and I know teachers and school leaders are on the front line witnessing the immediate impact of cost-of-living pressures on young people and their families.

That's why, as Chancellor I have made the economic choices which have enabled us to support households with £150 off energy bills, freeze rail fares and prescriptions and make increases to the National Minimum Wage and State Pension.

But I know that what matters for local families is not just getting by but being able to enjoy time together without worrying about the next bill. When budgets tighten, life's little treats can fall by the wayside – a meal out, a family holiday or a day trip making memories with your kids.

That's why I'm delighted to share the details of our Great British Summer Savings scheme which will help local families going into the summer holidays know those little joys with the kids are going to be more affordable.

The Government is taking action to slash VAT from 20% down to 5% on children's menu meals, children's tickets for cinemas, theatres and concerts from 25th June to 1st September. Adults and children will also be able to enjoy amusement parks, wildlife parks, museums, soft play centres and a wide range of other attractions for less. On top of this, kids from 5 to 15 years old will get free bus travel in England this August, making it cheaper for people to get out and about.
