OUR SCHOOL DAY

As you will see below the official start of the school day for Reception to Year 6 is at 8.45am. However, we believe that opening our doors ten minutes earlier creates a more pleasant atmosphere for our children.



This 'softer' start allows our staff to connect with the students as they arrive, providing the opportunity to comment on a new haircut or to share the latest news from home. It's a lovely way to ease into the school day and ensure that every child feels welcomed and valued.

All children and families to use the **Swinnow Lane entrance at the beginning and the end of the school day**. We will not be using any other entrances, and they will be shut. This has been reviewed following our Health and Safety audit that it is safest to have one entrance into school and out of school to ensure all pupils and families are welcomed by members of staff.

This will also mean that the Swinnow Lane Car Park will be closed to staff and families from 8:20am (unless you have been provided with a school Parking Permit or have a government issued Blue Badge displayed).

School/classroom entrance doors will open at 8.35am. Class registers will be taken at 8.45am and will close once the register has been taken. Any children arriving after 8.45am will need to go to the school office to sign in and will receive a Late mark on the register.



Our School Car Park

Staying Safe in the School Car Park

Please help us keep everyone safe. The school car park is for authorised users only. Entry is permitted with a valid school car park pass, which must be clearly displayed in your vehicle at all times. For the safety of our children and families, please avoid using the car park without a pass and follow all signage and instructions.



One-Way System in the Car Park

The school car park operates as a **one-way system** to improve traffic flow and safety. Please follow the directional signage and staff instructions. Thank you for helping us keep our site safe and efficient for everyone.

Car Park Pass System

If you would like to enquire about being issued a school Park Pass please speak to a member of the school office, where they will supply you with an application for, which will be reviewed.

You may be eligible for a pass if you hold a valid **Blue Badge**, or if school agrees there are other exceptional circumstances. Please note:

- All passes must be **displayed clearly** in your vehicle
- School reserved the right to **issue** or **withdraw** passed at any time, depending on need and use
- The car park WILL be closed when we are awaiting coaches for school trips.

We thank you for your cooperation as we ensure the car park remains safe, accessible, and fair.

Medication and First Aid

If your child needs to take any medicine and it can be taken less than 4 times a day, they **must** take this at home before and/or after school.

Medicine will not be kept in the school office and will be given to your child in their classroom. If you have an inhaler this will also be kept in your classroom. Epi-pens will still be kept in the school office to keep them safe.

It is the responsibilities of families to update us with any medical information possible. If there is a change to your child's medical information please contact the school office to inform us and we will take the appropriate steps.

If your child uses an inhaler during the school day please complete and asthma plan form from the school office.



SCHOOL GRID—LUNCH ORDERING



Following the successful transition to our SchoolGrid for ordering lunches we will continue to use this application and families MUST pre order their child(ren)'s lunch at least 24 hours before the following day. All families should have a log in for this (please check you emails if you are new to our school).

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive Universal Infant Free School Meals, while other pupils/families are entitled to receive Income Related Free School Meals, which is means tested by the government. Pupils who are moving in to Year 3 will no longer automatically get Free Meals unless you qualify for Income Related Free School Meals

In 2025 the threshold for qualifying for the Income Related Free School Meals has been reviewed and for some families who have not previously been entitled to this, you may now qualify and we encourage you to re-apply even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 as you may also qualify for other benefits which will help support you and your family. DRINKS THROUGHOUT THE DAY

It is important that children remain hydrated throughout the day and we will continue to allocate time for pupils to get a drink of water in between learning. Pupils will need to bring their own water bottle in to school with them.



Bottles will be returned home each Friday for a deep clean and will need to be brought back to school the following Monday. Please note that the ideal size for water bottles is 500ml maximum. Please ensure bottles are clearly labelled.

Your child will require a separate drink for their packed lunch or if they are school meals they will have water available in the dining hall.

Personal Belongings











To ensure a smooth and productive school day for all our students, we ask that students do not bring any personal items to school. We understand that some students may have certain comfort items, such as blankets or toys, which can help ease their transition into the school day. Where these items have been approved by the school, it is always with the intention of gradually reducing students' reliance on them. Things can get lost or broken and this causes distress.

Reading Books

Your child will bring a reading scheme book home every Monday and this should be returned to school the following Monday.

The reading record will be checked by your child's class teacher to ensure your child is reading three or more times a week at home.

Your child will also bring home a book to read for pleasure, they will have chosen from either their class or key stage library. When finished, this too should be returned to school on a Monday.



If either book is lost/not returned a charge will be added to your Arbor Account.

Your child will be provided with a plastic book bag to transport their book in.

Mobile Phone Policy

As a school we understand that mobile phones are a vital piece of technology for many families and children to ensure they are safe and to keep in contact. We ask that:

- Pupils in years 4, 5 and 6 **only** are allowed to bring a mobile phone to school.
- Phones **MUST** be handed in to the class teacher for safe keeping during the school day and switched off.
- If pupils are late into school, they must leave phones with the school office for safe keeping.
- Mobile phones will be returned to each pupil at the end of the school day and **MUST NOT** be switched on until they have left the school site.
- Pupil Mobile Phones are not permitted of School Trips and will be left in school for collection at the end of the school day/after the trip.
- For overnight stays, school discos and other school events, mobile phones are **NOT** permitted at all. If found these will be confiscated.
- Pupils must adhere to the school's acceptable use agreement for mobile phone use.

Holidays

We would like to remind families that, as from September 1st 2024, the law gives **no entitlement to parents to take their children on holiday during term time.**



Headteachers will not grant any leave of absence to pupils during term time unless they consider there to be 'exceptional circumstances'.

Schools are expected to consider each application individually taking into account the specific facts and circumstances and relevant background context behind the request. The DfE does not consider a need or desire for a holiday or other absence for the purpose of leisure and recreation to be an exceptional circumstance.



Thank you for your understanding and support in implementing this change to the law.

Reading

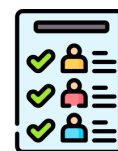
Children will bring a reading scheme book home every Monday and this should be returned to school the following Monday.

Your Arbor Account/App



Following lots of research, we have looked at the different systems that we are using for our communication and have been looking at ways to streamline the process and therefore make it easier for you as parents and carers.

We have already started using Arbor as our main pupil management system, which has been very successful! This new platform is crucial for our processes for attendance, communication, assessment, school trips, clubs, calendar and parents evening as well as providing us with an excellent tool for reporting.

Our new Arbor Parent App is now available for you to download and register. Please follow this useful guide below.

Park Spring Primary will be using Arbor Parent App for the following:

- Overview of your child's attendance.
- To report your child's absence.
- Overview of your child's personal information including medical and dietary requirement.
- To update the school if any details around your child's medical and/or dietary requirements have changed.
- To update your contact details or details of any other contacts or persons collecting your child.
- Parents' Evening bookings (Guardians' Consultations).
- To view your child's class trips information.
- To view your child's club information.
- To provide a consent for your child's photograph, local outing, walking home alone, etc.

In the future, we will also be using it for payments, assessment results, and more. We will keep you updated!
