SCHOOL DAY REMINDER

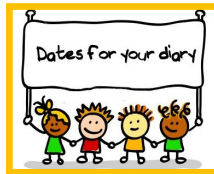

YEAR 6

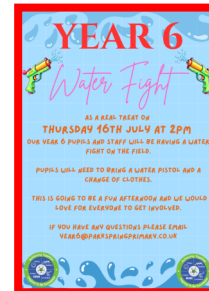

SKIPPING SCHOOL

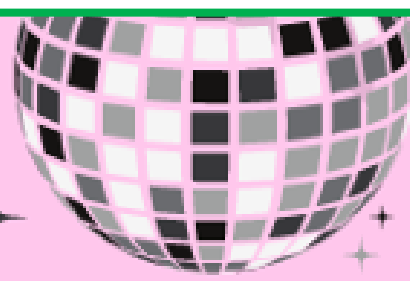

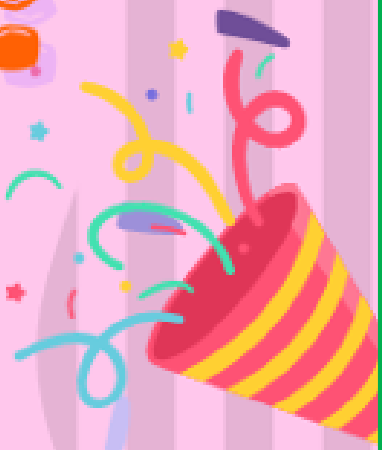
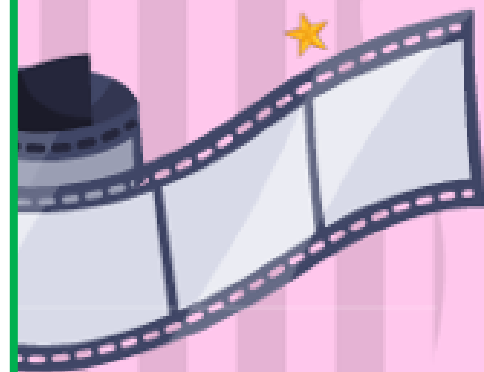
